Hampshire County Council will assess your situation and contact Winchester City Council or one of many voluntary groups which have set up to help people in our area and ask them to give you the help that you need.

If this contact is not possible, we are all happy to receive your calls at any time to help find the best way to support your needs.

Give Help

Voluntary groups should inform **Winchester City Council** direct about who they are and what they feel able to do to help. This will enable HCC being able to contact the most suitable group to give help.
